Parents will be required to sign our Youth Program waiver.

Sunday Morning guests will not be asked to sign the Youth Program Waiver until their third week of attendance.

Students will not be required to wear face masks in the Jesus classroom.

Volunteers will wear a mask while transitioning and will practice social distancing while teaching.

All surfaces will be wiped down after class, along with any equipment played with. Windows will be opened, if the weather permits.

Sick leaders and or participants will refrain from attending.

FRC will not be providing snacks for Sunday morning Nursery.

Kid Connection (1st-4th grade)

1-4th grade Students will not be required to wear face masks in the Kid Connection classroom.
