Call the office to schedule a time. Please do not provide childcare for your group.

#### FRC Reopens Safely and Joyfully **Protocol**

As we move back inside on June 7, the Executive team of Consistory requests the following to make it a great and safe experience.

- 1. Wear a mask, if you are willing. They are optional but encouraged. Rationale: we do not want to risk sickening anyone. And, we want to keep our reputation high in Fremont for both being cutting edge AND for safe.
- 2. There are 3 interior venues with seating prearranged at recommended social distance. Please find a seating pod appropriate to your number of household attendees.
- 3. There will be family friendly seating pods with coloring pages and tables. Please allow families with young children to make use of these.
- 4. There will be hand sanitizer prominently placed in all venues and by the church entrance door.
- 5. Please enter the building and leave the building promptly. Engage in fellowship opportunities outside and at safe, social distance.
- 6. If you feel concerned or unsafe, we suggest the drive in venue OR listening at home via our web site.
- 7. Doors will be propped open.
- 8. Consistory leadership and greeters will wear masks.
- 9. We request that all cycle through the 3 interior venues. DO NOT LOCK DOWN ON A VENUE. We suspect that the worship auditorium will be preferred by most. We want all share that venue by voluntary rotation. Each week choose a different interior venue. When you have done all three, then begin the cycle again. Consistory members and families will not sit in the worship auditorium on June 7 unless participating in worship.
- 10. There will be a deacon assigned to each of the 4 venues weekly. See the assigned deacon with any questions or concerns, call the office, or contact your elder.
- 11. Offerings will be received in the offering box located at the entrance door. An offering box will be available for the drive in venue.
- 12. Greeting time will be non touch. Practice your air hugs, air handshakes, and air high fives before the mirror prior to coming so you look smooth! Lol!
